Pittsylvania County Treasurer's Office to Remain Closed to the Public

CHATHAM, VA – The Pittsylvania County Treasurer's Office will remain closed to the public until further notice due to the current inability to ensure social distancing measures because of the physical layout and access to the office. Citizens are encouraged to use alternate payment methods including mail, phone, online, select banking locations and drop boxes.

The first installment of 2020 taxes including personal property, business personal property, real estate and the solid waste fee will be mailed out May 8 and are due by June 10. Payment options include:

- Mail – Treasurer's Office at P. O. Box 230, Chatham, VA 24531
- Phone – 1-800 Number will be listed on the back of the bill.
- Online – www.pittsylvaniacountyva.gov/treasurer
- Select banking locations – Any First Citizens or American National Bank in Danville and Pittsylvania County and both locations of First National Bank in Altavista
- Two drop boxes – One drive-thru box located behind the Treasurer's Office and one walk-up box located on the sidewalk leading into the courthouse.

Pittsylvania County recently announced in a [press release](#) that most of its government offices would reopen to the public for normal business hours on Monday, May 18. County offices have been closed to the public since March 25 due to the COVID-19 public health crisis.
